

New Jersey Equine Clinic Adoption Application

The New Jersey Equine Clinic Horse Adoption Program requires ALL applications be submitted with a \$10 processing fee and photos showing, at a minimum: fencing, gates, pasture, a barn/shelter picture and picture showing the stall to be used for the adopted horse as well as other horses owned by the applicant or housed on the property. NJEC may ask for additional pictures if details are unclear and will not process applications in the absence of photographs and the processing fee.
